RE: COVID-19 Update on the Opening of the Pool

Dear Residents of the Fairways Village Condominium Association:

We are pleased to announce that the Fairways pool will be opened for the 2020 season on **Saturday, May 30th.**

If you intend to use the pool this season, please carefully review the guidelines and procedures set forth below. These guidelines and procedures should be taken extremely seriously for your health and safety and for the health and safety of other residents using the pool facility. Non-compliance with these rules could result in loss of pool privileges and/or the closing of the pool.

Pool Hours of Operation

The hours of operation will be from 10:30am until 9:00pm Monday through Sunday.¹

Pool Rules and Guidelines

- Each resident who wishes to use the pool is required to sign a waiver regarding the COVID-19 virus. The waiver will be kept on file by Acri. A legal guardian is required to sign on behalf of minors. The waiver forms will be made available at the pool pavilion.
- Outside guests (who do not reside in the Fairways) are not permitted at this time, with the exception of one adult non-resident caregiver.
- All residents must practice proper hand hygiene and respiratory etiquette. All staff, patrons, and swimmers should wash their hands often and cover coughs and sneezes.
- Residents are to clean up after themselves. Please do not leave any personal items anywhere inside of the gate.
- We will not be storing any pool toys in the pool house this year.
- All residents entering the pool facility must wear a mask. Masks will be required when interacting with pool attendants at the pool, and should be worn at your discretion otherwise. Masks are not to be worn in the water.

- Social distancing is strongly encouraged. Pool lounges will be set up in six foot spacing (minimum). Two chairs will be placed at each table. Pool lounges and chairs are not to be moved.
- Reservation of tables and chairs for other residents is strictly prohibited.
- Disinfectants will be provided for residents to use to wipe down pool lounges and chairs, and any other items that they use. Staff members will be cleaning commonly used items daily as well, but we ask that you assist us by disinfecting any items that you use.
- Pool attendants will be present at various times for the maintenance of the pool facility and to assist with sign-in procedures. As in prior years, pool attendants do not provide life-guarding services. Residents are responsible for their own safety and are encouraged to exercise appropriate care when using the pool facilities.
- There will be NO rental of the pool and pavilion this year.

Sign-in Procedure

The pool will be restricted to 25 people at one time. To ensure compliance with the 25 person occupancy limit, residents must follow the below sign-in procedure:

1. There will be a sign up book placed on the outside of the pool gate. Residents who know when they will be swimming are encouraged to sign up for a time slot(s). This will help coordinate use of the pool and will help ensure that we stay compliant with the occupancy requirements.
2. There will also be a key-tag board with 25 tags at the pool gate. When you enter the gate, please turn a tag over to the red side. When you leave, please turn that tag back to the green side.
3. Upon arrival all residents (and non-resident caregivers) who use the pool must sign the guest book consistent with the practice in prior years.

When there is heavier demand for the pool (particularly on weekends and holidays), please moderate/limit the time you spend at the pool so that others have an opportunity to use the facilities.

The Fairways Council asks for your assistance in having a sunny, fun summer in the Fairways. We are working within the parameters issued by the CDC and local authorities to ensure everyone's safety. We will continue to be diligent and adapt to these guidelines and procedures as they change.
