

FAIRWAYS POOL SAFETY RULES

We hope that everyone is enjoying their summer so far. It has been wonderful seeing families and new faces this year enjoying the pool. The Fairways Council wants to make certain everyone continues to enjoy the pool and stay safe in process. The following are some reminders of rules put in place to maximize the pool experience for our residents and guests. - Residents and their guests are required to **sign in at ALL times.**
- **FIVE** total guests at a time per unit per day policy (including child guests)
- The first three guests are free. Guests #4 and #5 are \$5.00 each, regardless of age. **No Exceptions**
- Residents should be always present while their guests are there.
- At the present time, a pool attendant is on duty Tues- Fri from 4- close and Sat- Sun all day to ensure that residents check in and rules are followed but they are **NOT** a lifeguard.
- **PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE TO SUPERVISE THEIR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES.**
- Personal floatation devices are welcomed and encouraged for young children but are not a substitute for supervision. If your child cannot swim, please stay in the pool with them.
- Inflatable toys and should be taken out of the pool when not in use. On crowded days, their use will be at the discretion of the pool attendant.
- **NO RUNNING, PUSHING, ROUGH PLAY** or other inappropriate or offensive behavior is permitted in the pool or pool area. The attendant has the authority to remove people engaging in such conduct.
- Familiarize yourself with the location of AED, Safety line, First Aid Kit and Phone in case of an emergency. The address is **898 Fairways Drive**, should you need to call **911**.
- **The Oakmont CC siren will sound if lightening is in the area. If you hear this long siren, you must exit the pool immediately.** A series of shorter sirens will sound when it is clear.
- Please do your best to condense your trash (i.e., breakdown boxes)
- There is a recycling container for **PLASTIC BOTTLES and CANS ONLY.**
- Please treat the pool, pool area, shelter, Putting green and common property as it were your own. Please be respectful of other people at the pool.
- Failure to follow the Fairways Pool Rules, may result in temporary suspension of pool privileges.
